VARIETALS: 85% Tempranillo, 15% Garnacha (estate-grown 50-70 year-old vines)

AGEING: 24 months in French & American oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES: Tawny color of medium intensity. It stands out for its red fruits, prune and licorice scents wrapped in pastry, black pepper and vanilla hints from the oak barrel. Round, with pleasant structure, balanced acidity and elegant tannins.
