



SIGLO SACO | RIOJA (TEMPRANILLO)



VINTAGE: 2018

PRODUCER: Bodegas Manzanos

LOCATION: Azagra (Spain)

APPELLATION: D.O.C. Rioja

VARIETALS: 100% Tempranillo (estate-grown, 35 yr-old vines)

AGEING: 8 months in American & French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES: Intense cherry red color with a garnet rim. Medium-high intensity wine that stands out for its red fruit and floral notes in perfect harmony with the elegant toasted and vanilla notes from its time in oak barriques. Fresh, round, elegant with ripe tannins and a long aftertaste. Siglo's signature handcrafted burlap bag ("saco") dating back to the 1800s is still used today to keep the wine fresh and safe.
