



CABERNET SAUVIGNON RESERVA



Appellation:	Curicó Valley, Chile
Grape varietal:	100% Cabernet Sauvignon
Alcohol content:	13.5% ABV
Ageing:	6-8 months in French oak
Tasting Notes:	Red color with deep blue hues. In the nose, it shows aromas of bright red fruit, ripe plum and cassis combined with touches of coffee and vanilla. The palate is firm, with a tannic structure that gives it character, making it a long, persistent wine. Pair with pastas and meats, including lasagna, ravioli, fettuccini, pork, veal and beef.
About the Producer:	Vina Aresti was founded in 1951 by Vincente Aresti when he purchased a winery in the historic winemaking Curico Valley. In 2012, his daughters Begona and Ana Maria Aresti took over. They have continued their dad's push to produce quality wines, obtaining international quality certifications.
