Appellation: Curicó Valley, Chile

Grape varietal: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

Alcohol content: 13% ABV

Ageing: 2 months on the lees

Tasting Notes: A bright, greenish color with some elegant floral notes, citrus fruit and a hint of herbs. The palate has a firm acidity and pleasantly fills the palate, leading to a nice, persistent aftertaste. Perfect match for seafood dishes, ceviche, white cheeses, salads or sushi.
