TASTING NOTES:

This wine presents an intense, dark ruby red color. It has a medium-to-big body displaying notes of ripe blackberries and beautiful minerality. Its 12 months in French and American oak barrels add subtle flavors of mocha, coffee and coconut. Firm yet ripe tannins lead to a long and juicy finish. Ideal for lamb, red meats, aged cheeses and nuts.

ABOUT VIÑA ARESTI

Viña Arestí was founded in 1951 by Vincente Arestí when he purchased a winery in the historic winemaking Curicó Valley. In 2012, his daughters Begoña and Ana María Arestí took over. They have continued their dad's push to produce quality wines, obtaining international quality certifications (ISO 9001, ISO14001, BRC, HACCP) and Wines of Chile's environmental sustainability certification.

ABOUT CURICÓ VALLEY

Curico Valley is located in central Chile. The valley's climate is varied. The eastern part – closer to the Andes Mountains – is cooler than the western as it benefits from breezes coming down from the slopes of the Andes. The meltwater rivers Lontue and Teno that flow through Curico Valley before converging to form the Mataquito River have a significant effect on viticulture here. The region's soils are derived from limestone and volcanic rock from the Andes and have been deposited in the valley over time by the rivers (alluvial) as well as by gravity (colluvial).
