Sweet and juicy in the mouth, it has nice structure and soft, ripe tannins. Ideal for lamb, red meats, aged cheeses and nuts.

ABOUT VINA ARESTI

Vitia Aresti was founded in 1951 by Vincente Aresti when he purchased a winery in the historic winemaking Curic6 Valley. In 2012, his daughters Begof\a and Ana Marfa Aresti took over. They have continued their dad's push to produce quality wines, obtaining international quality certifications (ISO 9001, ISO14001, BRC, HACCP) and Wines of Chile's environmental sustainability certification.

ABOUT COLCHAGUA VALLEY

Colchagua Valley, in central Chile, is one of South America's most promising wine regions. It boasts a textbook wine-growing climate: warm, but cooled by ocean breezes and dry, but refreshed by rivers and occasional rainfall. The region's desirable terroir, combined with persistent, focused marketing has made this one of Chile's most important wine regions. The Tinguiririca River is a key feature in Colchagua. It flows along the northern edge of the region and through the town of Santa Cruz, around which many wineries are based. The river brings clear meltwater down from the Andean peaks to the valleys and vineyards below, transporting silts and clays with it and creating ideal soils and terrains for viticulture.
