ABOUT THE STELLENBOSCH REGION

Stellenbosch is perhaps the most famous wine-producing region in South Africa. The town, in Western Cape's Coastal Region, is steeped in history and is home to the country's best-known wine estates. Granite and sandstone soils are found throughout Stellenbosch. Their high clay content means that while they are freedraining, they have excellent water retention properties. Sufficient rainfall in winter allows growers to keep irrigation to a minimum.
