


- « ROME » = BRAMBLES, DRY STONE FENCE

THE WINE "CHÂTEAU ROMEFORT" WERE ATTACHED TO CHÂTEAU LAMOTHE
DE BERGERON, AND THE WINE WAS CLASSIFIED AS A "CRU
BOURGEOIS".


TODAY, CHÂTEAU LAMOTHE-BERGERON IS BRINGING THE WINE AND ITS HISTORY BACK TO LIFE BY REVIVING THE "CHÂTEAU ROMEFORT" BRAND. THE ORIGINAL PLOTS OF LAND HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED IN THE SOUTH OF THE VILLAGE OF CUSSAC-FORT-MÉDOC AND THE 18 HECTARES ARE DEDICATED TO THE PRODUCTION OF THIS WINE.
