IN THE 19TH CENTURY CHÂTEAU ROMEFORT WAS CREATED WITH AGRICULTURAL LAND DEDICATED TO PASTURE AND THE CULTIVATION OF VINES AND ORCHARDS.

IN THE 20TH CENTURY, THE VINEYARD PLOTS AND THE NAME OF THE WINE "CHÂTEAU ROMEFORT" WERE ATTACHED TO CHÂTEAU LAMOTHE DE BERGERON, AND THE WINE WAS CLASSIFIED AS A "CRU BOURGEOIS".

TODAY, CHÂTEAU LAMOTHE-BERGERON IS BRINGING THE WINE AND ITS HISTORY BACK TO LIFE BY REVIVING THE "CHÂTEAU ROMEFORT" BRAND. THE ORIGINAL PLOTS OF LAND HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED IN THE SOUTH OF THE VILLAGE OF CUSSAC-FORT-MÉDOC AND THE 18 HECTARES ARE

DEDICATED TO THE PRODUCTION OF THIS WINE. COLOR FRUIT INTENSITY ACIDITY BODY **TANNINS**

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
