

Chateau Tour Haut Vignoble

Saint-Estephe Grand Vin de Bordeaux 2019

Grapes: 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot and 1% Cabernet Franc

Tasting Notes: This wine has a fine and elegant bouquet, blending classic notes of raspberry and blackcurrant. The attack is full-bodied and fruity with a long finish of roasted notes.

Food Pairings: To be enjoyed with grilled beef and any type of cheese.

Wine Enthusiast: *"This wine's soft initial texture is misleading. Under the smooth tannins and ripe black fruits, the solid core will give the wine structure as it develops. Wait to drink until 2025."*

James Suckling: *"Sweet currant with spices and cedar aromas that follow through to a medium body with a solid core of fruit and tannins and a chewy finish. Structured. Give it time to come together and soften. 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot and 1% Cabernet Franc. Best after 2024."*
