Grapes: 100% Montepulciano

Tasting Notes: Intense ruby red in color. On the nose it has intense aromas with notes of black cherry, plum and violet. On the palate it shows notes of black cherry and plum as well.

Food Pairings: Pair this wine with pasta dishes with red sauce and mushrooms, or roasted red meat and game.

Winemaking & Aging: Fermentation of the skins at controlled temperature in steel. Aging for a few months into big oaken barrels from Slavonia

James Suckling: *"Aromas of overturned earth, coriander and wild blackberries. Medium-to full-bodied with plenty of tasty savory character. Fine, slightly chewy tannins. Black tea and forest herbs on the palate. Drink now."*

International Wine Report: *"The 2019 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo opens to inviting aromas of ripe sweet plums and cherries which are accented by hints of vanilla bean, spices and herbs. The palate is medium-bodied with a soft, inviting texture that continues through the velvety finish."*
