## "PAN" Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2017

• 90 points, James Suckling

Grapes: 85% Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon

**Tasting Notes**: Dark ruby red in color with light orange nuances. On the nose it is intense with aromas of mature red fruit and secondary spices smells. On the palate it is full, soft, and rightly tannic.

**Food Pairings:** Pair this wine with Hors d'oeuvre of delicatessen and ripening cheese, pasta dishes with red sauce and mushrooms, or roasted red meat and game.

**James Suckling:** "Lots of crushed black fruit on the nose and full palate, where well-integrated tannins push the fruit along for some time. No real complexity, but lightly oak, riserva-style structure that hangs together. Drink or hold."
