Lodi Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

- 90 points, International Wine Report

Grapes: Mostly Cabernet Sauvignon with a small amount of Petite Sirah

Tasting Notes: The Carving Board 2021 Lodi Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and a small amount of Petite Sirah. The result is a wine with clearly defined cassis combined with notes of plum and a touch of spice. The wine is rich on the palate featuring well integrated tannins and notes of toasty oak and vanilla richness to the finish.

Food Pairings: Serve with a variety of red meats, spicy sausage BBQ, wild salmon and aged cheeses for a relaxing treat.

Aging: Fermented in a rotary fermenter and transferred to 50% American and 50% French oak.

International Wine Report: *The 2021 Carving Board Cabernet Sauvignon begins with aromas of cherries and sweet plums woven together with spices, herbs and red licorice soaring from the glass. Medium-bodied with a velvety texture, laced with sweet red berry fruits, spices and herb nuances which lead up to the finish.*
