Tasty in the palate with good concentration and a finish marked by delicate notes of strawberries. A medium bodied wine with nice volume and long lasting ending.

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ABOUT VINA ARESTI

Vina Aresti was founded in 1951 by Vincente Aresti when he purchased a winery in the historic winemaking Curic6 Valley. In 2012, his daughters Begona and Ana Marfa Aresti took over. They have continued their dad's push to produce quality wines, obtaining international quality certifications (ISO 9001, ISO14001, BRC, HACCP) and Wines of Chile's environmental sustainability certification.

ABOUT CURICO VALLEY

Curico Valley is located in central Chile. The valley's climate is varied. The eastern part - closer to the Andes Mountains - is cooler than the western as it benefits from breezes coming down from the slopes of the Andes. The meltwater rivers Lontue and Teno that flow through Curico Valley before converging to form the Mataquito River have a significant effect on viticulture here. The region's soils are derived from limestone and volcanic rock from the Andes and have been deposited in the valley over time by the rivers (alluvial) as well as by gravity (colluvial).
