Tasting Notes: This full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon has great fruit flavors and smooth structured tannins. Aromas of black cherry, cassis, plum, slight blueberry, vanilla, oak and chocolate. A fruit forward wine with lush flavors, nice balance and a long silky finish.

Food Pairings: A perfect wine for pairing with grilled steaks, cheeseburgers, or rich red meat of any kind.

International Wine Report: "The 2021 No Name Road Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon opens with fresh aromas of blackberries and cherries which are woven together with spices, florals, herbs, and licorice. On the palate this is medium-bodied, soft and velvety, as flavors of ripe red/dark fruits, spices and floral notes lead up to the finish. This is accessible now, and should continue to drink nicely over the course of the next 2-5 years."

James Suckling: "Aromas of mulberries and dark cherries, blood orange, licorice and cocoa. Medium-to full-bodied with a sleek, chocolatey texture. Fine tannins and juicy finish. Drink now."
