TASTING NOTES:

This is a modern styled Pinotage that shows elegance and finesse. Rich, aromatic nose, complimented by lush, juicy fruit. A velvety palate with prominent notes of black and red berries, featuring spicy undertones of cinnamon. Dense fruit and integrated presence of wood makes this truly an experience to enjoy. This wine will pair well with most red meats or poultry.

PRODUCTION: 100,000 bottles.

ABOUT THE STELLENBOSCH REGION

Stellenbosch is perhaps the most famous wine-producing region in South Africa. The town, in Western Cape's Coastal Region, is steeped in history and is home to the country's best-known wine estates. Granite and sandstone soils are found throughout Stellenbosch. Their high clay content means that while they are free-draining, they have excellent water retention properties. Sufficient rainfall in winter allows growers to keep irrigation to a minimum.
