Grapes: 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot and 5% Malbec

Tasting Notes: Intense ruby red in color. Very fruity with notes of cherry, blackcurrants and discreet underlying spices. Great freshness and harmony. A classic, elegant red with round and silky tannins that results in a pleasant and long-lasting finish.

James Suckling: "Interesting nose of black berries and currants, colored with notes of savory black spice and graphite. Medium-to full-bodied with a tight bead of blackcurrant fruit, riding tight tannins that are firm but not chewy. Cabernet sauvignon, merlot, cabernet franc and petit Verdot. Drinkable now but best after 2024."

Wine Enthusiast: "Blackberries add pop to an otherwise earthy, umami nose of damp soil, cracked black pepper, green peppercorn and freshly brewed coffee. On the palate, black cherries bring out the sweet juiciness of the blackberries to headline the palate, although dusty, grippy tannins provide balance."
