

CHÂTEAU LA RIBAUD

CRU BOURGEOIS DU MEDOC

- 23 hectares, mainly in Saint-Yzans-de-Médoc with a parcel in Ordonnac.
- 5km away from Saint Estephe, the plots are touching some of the most prestigious chateaux in the region
- A blend of 56% Merlot, 37% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Cabernet Franc and 1% Malbec
- Clay-limestone plateau with deep clay
- Sustainable agriculture. The wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels (500L) and stainless steel tanks.
- "From clay soils, Château La Ribaud is a solid, attractive wine with subtle notes of blackcurrant, currant, tobacco and earth. Medium-bodied, with moderate tannins and a charming, well-balanced style, it will happily be enjoyed without delay."
